WCC WELCOMES SHINE CONFERENCE:

WCC had the pleasure and privilege to host the KNCSB SHINE event for teenage girls earlier this month. The girls and their leaders nearly filled the facility to capacity as they learned more about “What Is the Big Deal” concerning Galatians 2:20. As conference speaker Lynn Cowell of Proverbs 31 Ministries said, “What is the thing in your life that makes you feel insignificant or insecure? Today, I want you to take that thing and trash it. I want you to take that thing – your body, your brain, your lack of boyfriend or not being in the popular group – whatever it is that makes you lack confidence. I want you to trash it. Hebrews 10:35 tells us, ‘Do not throw away your confidence, it will be richly rewarded.’ We’re not! We’re going to cling to the confidence Christ has died to give us and throw away the thing in our life that comes against that confidence.”
